## BRISTOL AIRPORT - WITHDRAWAL FROM THE LOWER AIRSPACE RADAR SERVICE SCHEME

### 1 Background

1.1 Bristol Airport will leave the Lower Airspace Radar Service (LARS) Scheme on 1 March 2018 (AIRAC 3/2018).

### 2 LARS Provision in the vicinity of Bristol Airport

2.1 In accordance with the AIP ENR 1.6 a LARS may be requested from the following service providers in the vicinity Bristol Airport:

Yeovilton	510029N 0023845W	127.350	30	Mon-Thu 0830-1700 (0830-1600), Fri 0830-1400 (0830-1300).

2.2 Pilots requiring a LARS from the surrounding units should be aware that requests for an ATS may increase and therefore it may take longer to receive a response. Pilots requiring a Basic Service flying in the vicinity of Bristol and who intend to remain outside of Controlled Airspace (CAS) should consider calling London Information on 124.750 MHz.

### 3 Access to Bristol Airport CAS

3.1 Pilots requesting to join, transit or fly within 10 nm of Bristol CTA/CTR should call Bristol Radar on 125.650 MHz.

### 4 Aeronautical Charts

4.1 Pilots should be aware that the Aeronautical Chart ICAO 1:500,000 Sheet 2171CB, Southern England and Wales, will be updated on 29 March 2018 (Edition 44). The Topographical Air Chart 1:250,000 Sheet 7, The West and South Wales, will be updated on 10 October 2019 (Edition 12) and Sheet 8, England South, will be updated on 24 May 2018 (Edition 22).
